Consequences

Voice Levels

Voice Level	Sounds & Looks Like
ONE	- Whisper - Partner talk (Only your partner should be able to hear you)
TWO	- Regular talking voice - Table Talk (Only your table should be able to hear you)
THREE	- Presentation Voice
FOUR	- Outside Voice

Restroom & Water

- You will have 4 passes a semester to use for the restroom. For water, you may ask, and I can let you go as needed.
 - If you misuse the privilege of going to the restroom or using water (walking around, taking longer than usual) your privilege will be revoked.
- You may <u>not</u> go during the first or last 10 minutes of class (10 minute rule)
- You may go during group or independent work.
 - This means you will not go while I am teaching/notes.
- On test days, you may only go after your test is complete.



Tardiness

- Be on time every day.
- If you are tardy 3 times, you will receive detention in my classroom during lunch time. If you fail to attend detention, you will get a referral to the office.
 - This is the first consequence. If tardies continue after this, more consequences will follow.
- If late, come in silently and without interrupting others and get to work.

Cell Phones

- No Phones Allowed unless approved by teacher beforehand. (There will be times, I will allow you to use your cellphone during independent or group work).
- Please put your phone in your backpack when you walk in.
- If I see a phone during class time:
 - Warning
 - Taken up
 - If there is a reason you need to have your phone out, please have a conversation with me about it.

Electronics On Test Days

- <u>ALL</u> electronic devices must be put away during test times. No exception, except for chromebooks. If you have a cellphone out, you will receive an automatic fail for the test.
- You can have electronics back once <u>everyone</u> is finished testing.

Food & Drinks

- No food of drinks allowed.
 - Water is allowed. Water must be in a closed container with a lid and under your desk unless you are physically taking a sip.
- Occasionally, there will be candy or chips given out in class.
 - If I see wrappers on the floor after giving out candy, your class will lose the candy privilege.
